



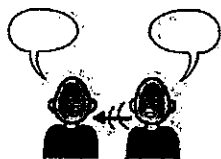

Language Development

- Expressive Language
 - The language used to communicate with others. Oral expressive language is the expression of thoughts and feelings through oral speech. Expressive language also refers to gestures and signing, as well as communication through objects, pictures and writing
- Receptive Language
 - A person's understanding of what is being communicated to them. It may be transmitted to the person through verbal, gestural, visual, or written communications

Auditory Processing

- Auditory processing disorder (APD), also known as central auditory processing disorder (CAPD), is a complex problem affecting about 5% of school-aged children.
- These students have difficulty processing and interpreting the information they hear.
- APD is an often misunderstood problem because many of the behaviors also can appear in other conditions like learning disabilities or attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD).

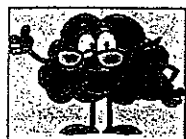

Articulation

- All of the motor processes involved in the planning and execution of sequences of overlapping gestures that result in speech
- Causes of Articulatory Disorders:
 - General difficulty getting all of the articulators working properly together
 - Young children whose articulators aren't fully developed yet.
 - Neurological damage that lead to motor control deficiencies
 - Cleft Palate
 - Malocclusion
 - » Overbite
 - » Underbite

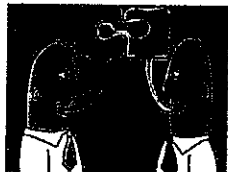

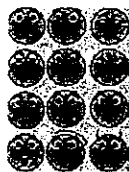
Social/Pragmatic Therapy

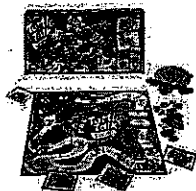
Fluency

- Stuttering affects the fluency of speech. It begins during childhood and, in some cases, lasts throughout life. The disorder is characterized by disruptions in the production of speech sounds, also called "disfluencies." Most people produce brief disfluencies from time to time.
- Disfluencies are not necessarily a problem; however, they can impede communication when a person produces too many of them.
